THE RULES



SCHEDULE



The Aramis Challenge is a 2 days competition event. The event offers **teams (Aramis Challenge) and individual (Porthos Tournament) competitions.**

The teams could be issued from clubs, inter-clubs, regionals or foreigners selections.

The teams must bid the online registration (<https://www.challenge-aramis.com/>).

2025 schedule :

SATURDAY

From 12.30 : Teams check-in

13.30 : Pools start

17.00 : « **PORTHOS Tournament** »

18.30 : « **PORTHOS Tournament** » Finals + Partners Cocktail

SUNDAY

08.00 : Teams report (the schedule may change depending on the number of participants)

09.00 : Seeding

16.00 : Teams Finals

17.00 : Awards



RULES



FORMULA :

- Teams relay formula is applied from FIE rules (*match up to 36 points for U15, up to 45 points for olders*) ;
 - Pools round : 4 teams pools ;
 - Seeding rounds : start at round of 32 (or 16) with byes, with full ranking match.
- => *As many assaults for each team, no draft.*

CONCEPT :

- The FFE technical and safety rules is applied ([Cf. French Fencing Federation website](#))
- A team consists of 3 fencers, with or without a reserve.
- The matches are following the relay formula.
- All fencers need a valid licence.
- Up to 16 women's teams and 24 men's teams.
- Registration priority (if necessary) :
 - Regionals teams
 - Foreign teams
 - Mixed club teams
 - Fencers ranking

REGISTRATION :

Online registration on website : <https://www.challenge-aramis.com/challenge>

French teams : Fill the form before to declare the fencers on to the federation website.

Men's team registration rules : One women's team allows a second men's team registration (if you don't have a women's team, you can't registered a second men's team).

Referee registration rules :

1st team => 1 referee

3th teams => 2 referees

In the event that it is not possible to mobilize an arbitrator, the organization will make its possible to provide one (*if requested in advance*).

A penalty of 120 € will be requested to compensate for his compensation and his reception.

Any registration will not be accepted after the Wednesday before the competition.

2025 ENTRY FEE : 75€ EACH TEAM

PORTHOS TOURNAMENT

RULES



ONE POINT TOURNAMENT :

The tournament is an integral part of the event and brings together all participants of the Aramis Challenge. It is also open to fencers of the weapon and category interested parties who would like to participate.

REGISTRATION :

No entry fee applied to the Aramis Challenge fencers (team event).

All other fencers must paid a 2€ entry fee for the Porthos Tournament.

The registration deadline for the Porthos Tournament is called 2 hours before the expected tournament beginning schedule.

SCHEDULE :

The schedule may be modified at the organisation advisory.

2025 expected schedule (Saturday) :

- 15h00 – Registration deadline
- 17h00 – Seeding : 1st round
- 18h30 – Final

PORTHOS TOURNAMENT

RULES



FORMULA :

One touch random seeding (use the « deciding hit » rules as it defined in the FIE t.38 rules) :
Deciding hit time limit : 1 minute
Before the deciding hit the referee draws lots to decide who will be the winner if scores still equals at the end of the extra time.
No loser's seeding.

PROCEED :

Competition progress in 2 stages :

- 1st stage : The fencers are divided in seedings along 8 or 16 strips (depends of the number of fencers).
- 2nd stage : The winners of the strips of the 1st stage enter the main seeding and become a finalist. The winner of the main seeding is the Porthos tournament winner.

PRIZE :

- Every finalist gets a gift of his performance.
- **The Porthos Tournament winner get an FIE Suit.**
